MINNEAPOLIS, Oct. 29, 2018 – During this busier-than-usual Medicare open enrollment season, UCare is opening its offices on select Saturdays to provide 1:1 assistance to Medicare shoppers. Licensed sales specialists will be on hand to answer questions and walk people through the enrollment process.

During the week, walk-ins are welcome Monday-Friday at UCare's NE Minneapolis and Hermantown offices during business hours. Minneapolis office hours are 8 am – 5 pm. Hermantown office hours are 8:30 am – 5 pm (Monday-Thursday) and 8:30 am – 3 pm (Friday).

Medicare Cost Plans are being phased out, meaning more than 300,000 individuals must find a new Medicare plan for 2019. Medicare shoppers have many questions this year as they research options to find a plan that includes their doctors and fits their health care needs and budget. UCare's expert "de-complicators" are here to answer questions.

Medicare open enrollment runs Oct. 15 – Dec. 7, 2018, for 2019 coverage.
