### Important Admission Notification Reminders

Inpatient admission notification is an important function of working with UCare members.

- It supports accurate and timely claims payment.
- It allows for better coordination with the hospital regarding ongoing care.
- It helps prepare the member for discharge.
- It promotes the engagement of UCare’s care management program post discharge.

Inpatient admission notification isn’t a substitute for prior authorization. Some services require prior authorization in addition to admission notification. Please visit the link below for preauthorization requirements:

<p><b>Observation status admissions</b></p>	<p>All hospitals that contract with UCare are expected to be compliant with the Notice of Observation Treatment and Implication for Care Eligibility (NOTICE) Act. The link is below:  <a href="https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Medicare-General-Information/BNI/index">https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Medicare-General-Information/BNI/index</a></p> <p>The Act requires all hospitals and critical access hospitals (CAHs) provide <i>both</i>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Written notification to the member; and,</li> <li>• Verbal/oral explanation of the notification to members receiving observation services in an outpatient status for more than 24 hours.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Maternity/Newborns</b></p>	<p>Notification of all newborns should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Delivery date</li> <li>• Delivery type</li> <li>• Birth weight</li> <li>• Level of care</li> </ul> <p>Note: Find the <a href="#">Birth Notification Form</a> on the <a href="#">Information and Resources</a> web page under “Hospital Resources.”</p> <p>Fax it to Clinical Intake at:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fax: 612-884-2499 or toll free fax: 1-866-610-7215</li> </ul>
<p><b>Intermediate levels of care:</b></p> <p><b>Long-term Acute Care Hospital (LTACH)</b></p> <p><b>Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation facility (AIR)</b></p>	<p>UCare requires prior authorization for Long-term Acute Care Hospital (LTACH) and Acute Inpatient Rehabilitation (AIR) admissions for all lines of business. Requests are reviewed for medical necessity in <i>advance and concurrently</i> throughout the admission and through discharge. UCare uses utilization triggers for utilization management and case management.</p> <p><b><i>*During the Covid-19 pandemic, UCare has temporarily changed prior authorization and notification requirements for certain post-acute care services effective for dates of service April 20, 2020, to Sept. 30, 2020.</i></b></p> <p>Please refer to: <a href="https://home.ucare.org/en-us/providers/provider-covid-19-faq/authorizations/">https://home.ucare.org/en-us/providers/provider-covid-19-faq/authorizations/</a></p> <p>Hospitals are expected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promptly provide adequate clinical information for any stay upon request.</li> <li>• Provide for reasonable access to hospital utilization review staff, as applicable.</li> </ul>

- Notify UCare when needs for case management or discharge planning support are identified.
