<b>What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b>	In-network: \$900/Individual; \$1,800/Family. Non-network: \$1,800/Individual; \$3,600/Family. <a href="#">Deductible</a> doesn't apply to in-network preventive care. <a href="#">Copayments</a> don't apply to <a href="#">deductible</a> .	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a> , each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a> .
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b>	Yes. <a href="#">Preventive services</a> , ER and office visits. The <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <a href="#">plan</a> , they have to meet their own <a href="#">out-of-pocket limits</a> until the overall family <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> has been met.
<b>What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a>?</b>	<a href="#">Premiums</a> , all non-network services, non-network balance-billed charges, and health care services this plan doesn't cover. ### Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes
